
First, we'd like to congratulate our new Adult Extension Head Coach James Wells in, to finally take over for Shane, and take us to even an entirely NEW level.



First revived out in Meridian Town ship by Coach Shane Tisdale around the time of 1998, it once more will take full form in 2008/2009 seasons. But, it will again be owned by the Co-Founders, no one else.

What will happen with LA Live again in the future? No one knows, but what I can personally say is that this time will be different in one

part: whether sticking around or not, all of what Camp Tisdale does will support them in every way.




Since our donations started in 2006, our brother club has gone on to now have a total facility
